2021 DISTINGUISHED AMERICAN AWARD



William W. Bradley

Senator William W. Bradley, 77, is a Managing Director of Allen & Company LLC. From 2001-2004, he acted as chief outside advisor to McKinsey & Company's nonprofit practice. He was a Senior Advisor and Vice Chairman of the International Council of JP Morgan & Co., Inc. from 1997-1999. During that time, he also worked as an essayist for CBS evening news and was a visiting professor at Stanford University, University of Notre Dame and the University of Maryland. Senator Bradley served in the U.S. Senate from 1979 – 1997 representing the state of New Jersey. In 2000, he was a candidate for the Democratic nomination for President of the United States. Prior to serving in the Senate, he was an Olympic gold medalist in 1964 and a professional basketball player with the New York Knicks from 1967 – 1977 during which time they won 2 NBA championships. In 1982, he was elected to the Basketball Hall of Fame. Senator Bradley holds a BA degree in American History from Princeton University and an MA degree from Oxford University where he was a Rhodes Scholar. He has authored seven books on American politics, culture and economy, including his latest book *We Can All Do Better*. Currently, Senator Bradley hosts *American Voices*, a weekly show on Sirius XM Satellite Radio that highlights the remarkable accomplishments of Americans both famous and unknown.



2021 CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE GAME AWARD

Andre Tippett

Andre was born in Alabama and grew up in Newark, NJ. A product of Barringer High School, where he was a three sport standout athlete lettering in football, wrestling and track and field. He was recruited by the University of Iowa and was two time All-Big-Ten in 1980 & 1981, and All-American in 1981. He helped lead the Hawkeyes to their first winning season, their first Big Ten title and the first Rose Bowl appearance in two decades.

He was subsequently drafted in the 2nd round by the New England Patriots in 1982, where he played 11 seasons at linebacker from 1982-1993. He was a 5 time Pro-Bowler, NFL Defensive Player of the Year, AFC Player of the Year, NFL 1980's All-Decade Team, NE Patriots Hall of Fame, '100 sacks Club", 2x 1st team All Pro, and 2X 2nd Team All Prow. In 2008 he was enshrined in the NFL Hall of Fame in Canton, Ohio.

This year, the National Football Foundation, the parent organization of our chapter will be inducting Andre into the College Football hall of Fame in December, 2021.

He has studied martial arts for over three decades and holds a 6th degree black belt in Uechi-ryu karate and is certified under the Okinawa Karate-do Association based in Okinawa, Japan.

Andre and wife Rhonda, reside in Massachusetts, with their three daughters and a son.

He currently serves as Executive Director of Community Affairs for the New England Patriots.





2021 DISTINGUISHED COACH AWARD

Brian Bowers

The Distinguished Coach Award provides recognition to those whose efforts to support the NFF and its goals have been local in nature and who have made significant contributions to the game of football in which it is played, and coached, both on and off the field, while providing examples of perseverance, leadership, and sportsmanship.

This year's award winner, Coach Brian Bowers, supports the Foundation's fundamental creed without flaw.

Coach Brian Bowers has served as Delbarton School's Head football coach for the past 18 years. Under Coach Bowers' leadership, the Green Wave have won eleven conference championships, competed in five State Championship games - and sent scores of players on to prominent college football programs around the country. Coach Bowers was awarded the Morris County Coaches Association "Bill Regan Coach of the Year" Award in 2012 and, again last year in 2020.

Before being named HC in 2003, Bowers served as an assistant coach under HC John Kowalik for 6 years. Prior to arriving at Delbarton, Bowers coached at Williams College, the University of Pennsylvania and at Stony Brook University.

Coach Bowers is a 1991 graduate of Union College where he played tight end. His 1989 Union College team played in the Division III National Championship (Stagg Bowl) game. Coach Bowers is a member of the History department and he currently teaches the Senior Leadership class.

Coach Bowers is also the Assistant Director of Athletics. Brian and his wife Melanie are the proud parents of three daughters - Lexi, Mary and Tessa.



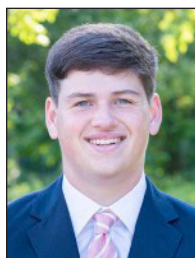
