It was clear that his daughter Finley was the center of his universe and even at a young age, she reflects his joyful spirit. 2022 DISTINGUISHED AMERICAN AWARD

BRENDA MATTI-OROZCO



Known for her compassion and leadership, Dr. Brenda Matti-Orozco, MD, is board-certified in internal medicine and hospice and palliative medicine. She is the founding chief of the Division of General Internal Medicine and Palliative Medicine of Morristown Medical Center and medical director of the hospital's Nancy & Skippy Weinstein's Inpatient Hospice and Palliative Care Center. Dr. Matti is also director of Internal Medicine Faculty Associates (IMFA), a physician practice of Atlantic Medical Group, and an associate director of Atlantic Hospice. Under her leadership, the practice has been recognized by the National Committee for Quality Assurance as a Level 3 Patient-Centered Medical Home since 2017. The practice is also a participant in the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services Innovation Program on Comprehensive Primary Care. Additionally, Dr. Matti serves as medical director of the palliative care program at Chilton Medical Center and current chair of the Atlantic Accountable Care Organization board.

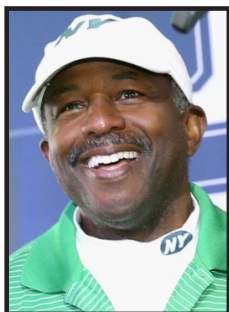
As a fellow of the American College of Physicians with board-certification in both hospice and palliative medicine as well as internal medicine, Dr. Matti has been helping patients and families navigate living with serious illness and end-of-life care for more than two decades. She is a strong advocate for patients' needs and inspires her staff to do the same. A seasoned mentor that is both educator and clinician, Dr. Matti has utilized her American Hospital Association's Health Care Transformation Fellowship to drive change and innovation in medicine and health care delivery while providing direct care as a general internist and palliative care specialist in both outpatient and inpatient settings.

Her professional career has been defined by the pursuit of excellence in patient care and health service delivery systems across the continuum of aging, health, and illness. Since joining Atlantic Health System in 2015, she has been instrumental in the transformation of primary care internal medicine into an advanced model that is patient-centered and value-based, and in bringing innovation to clinical education, training, research, and in improving the quality of care of patients.

Dr. Matti attended medical school at the University of Santo Tomas in the Philippines and conducted her residency at Saint Luke's-Roosevelt Hospital Center in New York.

2022 CONTRIBUTION TO THE GAME AWARD

BRUCE HARPER



Bruce is a retired professional kick returner and running back for the NY Jets of the NFL. Bruce played high school football at Dwight Morrow HS in Englewood, NJ. He played his college football at Div. III Kutztown State College, where he was the school's first 1000 yd rusher and subsequently was signed as an undrafted free agent in 1977 by the NY Jets. Bruce Harper is the all-time kick returner in NY Jets history with 5,407 yds in returns. He also served as the Jets punt returner from 1977 to 1982, totaling 1,784 yds and a TD. He also played running back. His total yds are 11,429: 1829 rushing, 2,409 receiving, 1,784 punt returns and 5,407 kick returns.

He led the NFL with more than 2000 all purpose yds for two consecutive years and he led the AFC in the same category for four years. He was voted the Jets MVP in 1980, was a two time Pro-Bowl alternate, and held nine Jets records at one time. With several of those records still standing today. In 2003 Bruce was selected as the Return Specialist on the Jets' Four Decade Team

And to show you players that there's life after football, Bruce works as an Ambassador with the NY Jets, is a Board member of the Lodi Boys and Girls Club and the Englewood Hospital and Medical Center Foundation Board.

If that's not enough, Bruce Harper is the founder and director of the not-for-profit organization, 'Heroes and Cool Kids', established in 1998. Based in school systems throughout NJ, the mentoring program reaches out to elementary and middle school kids by high school athletes and students in the same district. The high school students are trained through the Heroes and Cool Kids curriculum, and by former professional athletes from the NFL and the NBA.

Bruce's # 42 Jersey is worn at every game by diehard Jets fan 'Fireman Ed' who can be seen in the stands at Met Life Stadium donning his fireman hat and leading the cheers.

2022 DISTINGUISHED COACH AWARD

MIKE SABO



Over the last 19 years, Mike Sabo has made an immense impact on the not only the Morris Hills football program, but also the players, coaches, students, staff, administration, and Morris County Football community. This impact continues to be passed along through the doctors, lawyers, engineers, businessmen, teachers, coaches, administrators, and police officers who learned what it took to be great under coach Sabo.

Mike Sabo grew up in Wharton and was obsessed with Morris Hills Football. He went to every game since he was 8 years old and knew the scores of the games, the players, the coaches, and eventually became a player and a proud Morris Hills graduate in 1992.

Being hired as head football coach in 2004 was a dream come true. It was the only head football coaching position he ever interviewed for and the only one he ever wanted.

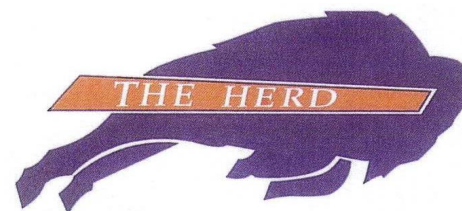

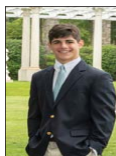

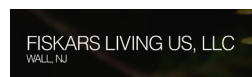
